

## 2M USB 1.1 TYPE A -B CABLE

(USB-CAB)

Available in various range from 2/3/5M



USB 1.1 is a Universal Serial Bus (USB) standard, released in August 1998. The USB 1.1 standard has been all but replaced by USB 2.0, and soon by USB 3.0.

USB 1.1 is sometimes called Full Speed USB.

There are actually two different "speeds" at which a USB 1.1 device can run at - either Low-Bandwidth at 1.5 Mbps or Full Bandwidth at 12 Mbps. This is considerably slower than USB 2.0's 480 Mbps and USB 3.0's 5,120 Mbps maximum transfer rates.

**Important:** USB 1.0 was released in January 1996 but issues in that release prevented widespread support for USB. These problems were corrected in USB 1.1 and are the standard that most pre-USB-2.0 devices support.
